2011 MTMI ANNUAL INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE On Global Issues in Business & Technology

The Modern Technology and Management Institute, (MTMI) invites papers for its 2011 Annual Conference which will be held at Metro Points Hotel, New Carrollton, Maryland, USA during 20-22 October 2011. **The conference is sponsored jointly by the University of Maryland Eastern Shore, and the Bowie State University.** The conference will provide an opportunity for participants from business, government, academia and industry to share and discuss their ideas to develop strategies for developing efficient digital business opportunities and partnerships for secured services in global markets.

Papers are limited to 6 pages with all margins 1" each.
